The Symposium is open to all law offices that meet the CLOP Child Welfare Law Office definition: "A Child Welfare Law Office is defined for the purpose of this project as an entity operated for the purpose of delivering legal services to children and youth. The office must have substantial involvement / concentration in the practice of child welfare law (abuse, neglect, and dependency) and must employ a minimum of three (3) full-time staff attorneys with substantial involvement in child welfare law." Participating offices are asked to send 2 representatives, preferably the Executive Director / CEO and the Administrator / Office Manager. The cost per office is \$200.
