

**Colorado Government, LAWS 7255, fall 2012 Tu-Th 9:00-10:15**

This is CU's current curricular offer on local government law. National casebooks on the subject hop from state to state at random. I have found it more coherent to cover only Colorado. Course readings are an electronic casebook of about 370 pages that I composed and revise before each offering of the course. It is provided to those enrolled at no charge.

What if you plan to practice in another state? Course content overlaps other states that have the initiative (California, Florida, Oregon, etc.) around 85%. Overlap with other states is less but substantial except for Louisiana.
